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Caring more for the newborn babies at HFH

The concern for the health of our newborn babies grows with every tiny heart beat born in the hospital. Better maternal care, healthier generation, and a balanced body are our great ambitions. At Holy Family Hospital, skin-to skin bonding of the mother with her newborn and insuring a strong natural relationship starts from the first moments in the delivery room where the midwife brings the baby close to his mother's body immediately after birth. Attempts to breastfeed are indeed as well encouraged during the first hour of contact. This month, we were pleased to host Ms. Kathryn MacQuillan and Mrs. Maeve Dwyer during their regular visits to HFH through the visiting professors program. This visit, Mrs. Dwyer was accompanied by Ms. Maureen Fallon, National Breastfeeding Coordinator at the Department of Health and Children- Dublin, Ireland, who spent approximately seven years as Assistant Director of Midwifery Services at the National Maternity Hospital, Holles Street, and also worked as Public Health Nurse for about 14 years in the eastern region. Ms. Fallon carried out a five-hour training workshops and lectures in the hospital in the presence of more than 28 nurses from the nursing and midwifery team, were leaflets and other materials were distributed emphasizing the numerous health advantages for the mother and baby, the new researches and the differ-

ent approaches. With the support and sponsor of **Tommee Tippee**, an internationally renowned manufacturer of different baby products, we finished the setting up and designing works of a "breastfeeding room" with a private relaxing atmosphere where the nursing team can better educate the mothers and help them breastfeed their newborns. The mothers staying in the hospital are invited to attend a session or more on how to deal with a newborn baby, his bath time, and his early stages. The room can be easily accessed to breastfeed if the mother desires a change from the atmosphere of the hospital's room. It is located in the post-natal department, with pleasant colors, cozy seating, and displayed items to help demonstrate to mothers.

We are glad to be the first maternity hospital in the West Bank who creates such a space for the new mothers and babies and add value to the care we provide our patients with.
