Inauguration of the expansion of Holy Family Hospital outreach clinic to include the Pediatric and neonatal care in addition to the existing maternal care

On November 10th, 2013 H.E. Vice Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Mr. Didier Reynders visited Holy Family Hospital and celebrated alongside H.E. Dominique de La Rochefoucauld, President Delegate, H.E. Abed Al-Fatah Hamayel, Governor of Bethlehem, H.E Bruno Jans the Belgium Consul General in Jerusalem accompanied by other Belgium delegates and Holy Family Hospital staff, the inauguration of the expansion of Holy Family Hospital outreach clinic to include the Pediatric and Neonatal Care in addition to the existing Maternal Care project. This was achieved through a subsidy granted by a Royal Decree dated February 19, 2013 of H.M. King Albert II and upon a proposal by H.E. Mr. Reynders for the benefit of the Palestinian people with the support of Malta Belgium International, an affiliate of the Belgium Association of the Order of Malta.

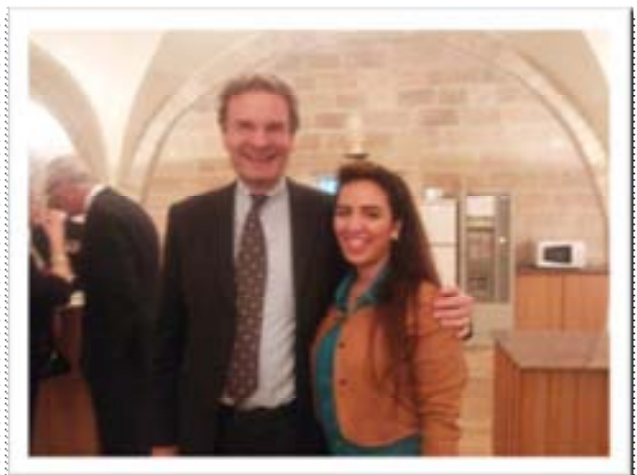
