We are also keen to reform the over 45 well women health clinic established on October 2012 by recruiting a female doctor of the same age so to easier facilitate the communication with the women who are having a problem of the age over 45, it is essential to establish this clinic as the women over 45 years old have many conditions that may lead to increase morbidity rate in this population, these conditions are considered by the women as a normal physiological reactions after multiple pregnancies and births such as urine incontinence, pelvic organ prolapsed.....etc.

Many women are not aware also about the screening of illnesses during this age such as breast, cervical and endometrial cancer, osteoporosis and others, for that our role is to increase and improve the population awareness of these conditions by performing a communication session in the villages of the region. Such a project and awareness cannot be established without the support of our donators, and our initiatives as a management committee of the Holy Family Hospital.

As in all the western hospitals we are obliged to review all the hospital guidelines and protocols every 2-3 years depending on which policy we are working on, for this year we will start to review the guidelines mainly related to the high risk pregnancy and the premature babies, we would like to thank our visiting professors from Europe and USA who took the initiatives previously to encourage the CME (Continuous Medical Education) for all the staff of the Holy Family Hospital. We have also to insist and work on strengthening, the important role of the staff of the hospital to help us maintain the high standard care and to motivate them to work on a harmonic atmosphere.

Medical Waste Management System



The Medical Waste Sterilizer donated to Holy Family Hospital by the American People through the U.S Agency for International Development under F.O.G #294-F-12-00001 was installed successfully and is in operation since December 2012. This system is the first system installed in Bethlehem district for Sterilizing the Medical Waste. The System works on shredding and sterilizing the Medical Waste that is clean enough to be disposed in the regular garbage, thereby decreasing the threat of contamination to the environment and reducing the potential of endangering the public's health. The system can handle all kinds of medical waste; pathological waste, and sharpness generated from all the hospitals' different departments.
