Mrs. Rawan Hazboun A total of 22 OBGYN residents and midwives were trained from different 5 hospitals mainly from the south area plus (Yatta, Beit Jala, Hebron, Holy Family & Makassed Hospitals). There were 8 qualified trainees from Holy Family Hospital. The training course focused on basic neonatal resuscitation skills (supported in part by Brigham and Young University through provision of manikins) it consisted of 1 day of Helping Babies Breathe, followed by 2 days of Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics. The Director of Juzoor Foundation Dr. Salwa Najab declared that the main objective of this course is to work hard to protect the mother and the child birth, also to try to reduce the mortality rate in the Palestinian communities.

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
