Over the last few years, Holy Family Hospital has become the major provider of maternal and newborn healthcare in the District of Bethlehem, preserving a level of care that is comparable to anywhere in the civilized world and while keeping the door always open to the needy and destitute.

This could not have been possible without the continuous support of the Holy Family Hospital of Bethlehem Foundation and the Sovereign Order of Malta.

Nowadays, we are marking an increasing in the load of work about 65% compared with the previous months. The activity of the hospital continues to grow steadily with an increase in normal deliveries and a decrease in complicated cases. The increase is also seen in the patients coming to the outpatient clinics
